
# Reading Sentences




# Word Games





# Jolly Phonics 1 - Play the phonics board game

Roll a dice and read the word you land on. If you cannot read the word, you go back one space. If you land on an empty space, you have no word to read and you stay there. The first person to reach the ship (bottom right) wins the game.
